

Storm Policy

CMHA follows the storm cancellation policies for HNS & the leagues it participates in above the IP/Novice level. CMHA, MMHA.

Please see Hockey Nova Scotia Winter Travel Protocol Jan 22, 2020 "In the case of bad weather and/or poor road conditions that may prevent teams and on-ice officials from safely travelling on highways to games, the following protocols are to be used: Safety of the players and on-ice officials is the primary concern. However, teams should make every effort to play scheduled games when possible."

CMHA Storm Policy:

Coaches:

Once decision is made by the coaches to cancel, call appropriate VP (rec, novice, ip, comp) and the ice scheduler.

Call your players

VP Recreation, VP Competitive, VP Novice, Ice Scheduler:

VP & Ice Schedule agree/confirm who is contacting the following:

Call contact at other affected team(s), association(s)

Call Chief Referee to cancel ref's

Call rink

Contact CMHA Ice Coordinator directly by phone and email if the team decides it is not safe to travel to a game due to bad weather. This cancellation request MUST be made at least 2.5 - 3 hours prior to the start of the game (whenever possible) so that game officials and the opposing team can be notified.
