Draw dates: Oct. 31st, Nov. 28th, Dec. 19th, 2021, Jan. 30th, Feb. 27th, Mar. 27th, and April 24th, 2022.

This lottery is approved for online sales with the selected service provider. Licensee must take all proceeds and pay service provider after they receive all funds.

The use of a Random Number Generator (RNG) is approved to determine the winner of this lottery.

The contract provided to AGFT between this group and the service provider is the only valid contract to conduct this lottery.

Lotteries with jackpots exceeding \$100,000 will require oversight by a Chartered Professional Accountant (CPA) to ensure the integrity of the lottery.

The CPA must be a separate entity from the membership body, association, or lottery scheme and must be capable of auditing the lottery scheme at AGFT's request.

One bank account must be used for all lottery finances.

Payments to winners cannot be made through Electronic payments.

This Ticket Lottery License is subject to the 2.13%. of the total prize value.

This lottery covers the approved organization listed on the conditions only.

Funds raised from this lottery cannot be used for any form of personal gain.

The organization listed on this license is responsible for the management and conduct of this license.

Tickets cannot be purchased as a gift online.

Only one name is to be printed entered on a lottery ticket. Only one person is to win the prize.

The use of numbered balls to determine the winner of the lottery are not permitted.

Changes cannot be made to this license once it has been issued.
