

HRM 4-Pad Rental Group Checklist Rules to keep patrons, players and staff safe. COVID Vaccination Policy

Prior to signing contract and gaining access to the facility:

	Waiver form must be signed prior to first rental, no exceptions. All payments must be made through e-transfer, credit card or cheque prior to the first rental.
	Insurance certificate must be submitted prior to first rental. Nustadia Recreation & HRM
	must be added to insurance as 3 rd party. HRM offers short term insurance program and more

	Effective December 17, 2021, the maximum number for Field of Play for minor sport will
	be limited to 60 (coaches, players, timekeepers, officials, dressing room monitors, etc).
	Provincial or minor sport organization may set their own limit but may not exceed 60.
	Effective December 17, 2021, the following maximum number of spectators will be in place:
	A, B & C arenas 50 spectators. Arena D will have a limit of 150 spectators. Provincial or mino
	sport organizations may set their own limits but are not to exceed the limits stated above.
	It will be the responsibility of each minor sport group to control the number of spectators
	entering the facility for each rental. Spectators can enter 5 minutes before the rental time
	and must exit 10 minutes after the end of the rental.
	Keys must be obtained for dressing room assignments. All user groups are reminded to use
	the dressing rooms assigned. Doors are to be locked prior to returning keys. Dressing room
	keys will be exchanged for car keys.
	User groups will have access to their dressing rooms 30 minutes prior to their rental. They
	are encouraged to vacate the dressing as quickly as possible after the rental.
	Players are encouraged to come dressed and ready to play.
	Masks are mandatory
	Participants (including spectators) will continue to use the main entrance
	All users entering the facility should be prepared to show proof of vaccination
	Be mindful of signage in the facility and always follow directions from staff.
	Food and drink are <u>NOT</u> permitted in the facility
	Private sport operators should follow the guidelines put in place by their respective provincial sport organizations.
	Informal gathering limits of 20 people indoors will remain in place (i.e., birthday parties,
	family skates, etc.)
	No tournaments are permitted
